





Patient is a 84 year old female from the Emergency Department. Primary history of chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, congestive heart failure, high blood pressure, and atrial fibrillation. Prior surgical history of coronary artery bypass graft times 4, right total knee replacement, left total hip replacement. History of vancomycin resistant enterococcus, methicillin resistant staphylococcus aureus. Will need peripheral inserted central catheter, chest x-ray, type and cross for 2 units packed red blood cells without delay.

Ah! That's better.....

Role and **Function** of the Legal Nurse Consultant

- Providing definition of nursing and medical terminology
- Preparing chronological chart summaries
- Providing consultation and education on the nursing process and standards of care
- Reviewing depositions of physicians, nursing staff and ancillary staff (OT, PT, RT, etc.)
- Applying current medical and nursing research.
- Reviewing medical records, including lab results and autopsy reports

A good LNC gives not only translation but CONTEXT to you about your cases.




Client Interviews

Acquisition

- Ain't nobody got time for that...
- Knowing:
 - What do you actually need?
 - Where to look?
 - Who to ask?
 - Did you get what you asked for?
- How far back to go?
- Client Interview!

Medical Records cont.

- Analysis
 - What happened medically?
 - Telling a story
 - Documentation discrepancies
 - Facility compliance, Gold-standard/protocol adherence
 - What's missing?

Medical Records cont.

- Summary
 - Chronolocial order of events
 - Medical jargon vs Legalese?
 - What does it all mean?
 - Context- Lab values, medical terms, policy, acronyms, medications
 - What helps? What hurts?

Autopsy

- Typical, non-specific findings in all body systems.
- No internal bleeding noted.
- No head Injury noted.
- Undetermined bruising noted to forehead.
- Fresher bruising notedto abdomen and buttocks

- Organ Weights:
 - Heart- 85gm
 - Lungs- R 107gm L 104gm
 - Liver- 590gm
 - Spleen- 100gm



- Brain- 1235gm
- Kidneys- R64gm L65gm

 - Serum vs whole samples
- Police Reports
 - Field sobriety tests vs serum vs breathlyzer
 - Behavior prior to hospital and staff response
- Fire Department reports

POST-CONVICTION


- Consults for probation violations
