Personnel Records

Training, Qualifications

- College Transcripts
- Training documents
 - Competency
 - Proficiency
- Continuing Education
 - Advanced degree
 - Professional seminars
 - Workshops

Experience

- Casework
- Annual Proficiency Testing
 - Internal
 - External
- Publications
- Testimony Reviews
- Certification

What can you find out about the testing/ materials?

Testing Materials:Chemicals/Reagents

- Process Validation
 - Who developed the test?
 - In House
 - Manufactured
 - Experiments
 - Specificity
 - Accuracy
 - Repeatability
 - Sensitivity
 - Identify potential NCTs

- Write Procedure
 - How and when is it used?
 - Quality Control
 - Possible results
 - Documentation
 - Conclusions
 - Reporting
- Train Staff
 - Read validation report
 - Use Procedure
 - Test unknowns

How do I know what was done on a case?

Documentation

- What was done?
 Is there a procedure?
- Who did it?
 - Was this person qualified?
- How was it done?
 - Was the procedure followed?

- Field and Bench notes
- Photographs
- Scans
- Electropherograms
- Spectra
- Communications
- Chain of Custody
- Remaining material and Disposition

What can you find out about this equipment?

Equipment

- Must be validated or performance checked before use on casework
- Must be performance verified on a predetermined schedule
 - Must undergo routine maintenance
 - Quality Control checks before use each time
- Records of all maintenance

Reporting Process

- Does the examination involve "verification"
 - If yes, complete prior to drafting report
 - If no, draft report
- Put draft report out for Technical Review/Admin Review
 - Technical must be done by another qualified analyst
 - Admin-grammar, methodology, equipment, disclaimers, etc.
- After reviewer approval, author publishes

Amended Report

- Occurs when a substantive error is found in a previously approved report
 - Error or omission of data
 - Could impact the interpretation and/or conclusions
- Must be approved by Quality Assurance Manager or Director
- Must go through technical review again

Non-conforming testing

- Define what happened
- Determine why it happened
- Is there a simple fix?

- Does the nonconforming testing
 - Have the potential of recurring?
 - Illustrate a pattern?
 - Indicate that lab cannot operate under it's own procedures

Corrective Action

- No simple fix
 - Root Cause Analysis
- Remediate
- Report to ANAB
- Review
- Repeat if necessary

- Root Cause Analysis
 - What were the points of failure
 - Try to get to one root cause but more than one may be a reality
 - Usually a possible root
 cause leads to the true
 root cause
 - Documented in Case
 Record

Preventive Action

Something happened or might happen

Communication

Will there be a potential impact to future decisions, processes, judicial proceedings?

Discovery

- Case specific records
 - -Reports
 - -Notes
 - -Photographs
 - -Raw Data
 - DNA
 - Chemistry-Spectra
 - -Communication
 - -Chain of Custody

Post-Conviction Relief

- Archived evidence
 - The item itself
 - Child of a parent item
 - Something removed from the actual item
 - Retained in a lab designated "vault"
 - Freezers, dry storage, microscope slide drawers, test fires, old lab files
 - Paper lab files dating back to 1970s at least
 - Latent lift cards from decades back
